So, for many people it is **easier to keep their illusion**, stay in the white "pure" bubble, chant the mantras, and continue the teachings as usual. **They need it as their stabilizing factor**. Take it away from them - they will be without foundation.

One must have built already some sort of inner ground to walk on when stepping out of all."
